This is in direct contrast to many CRO sites who lay emphasis on the use of space. I do not think that I have seen a CRO doing BA/BE studies, laying emphasis on nature and the environment around. I must have visited almost all the major CRO's in India - have dealt with them at some time or the other and quite a few in Toronto and other places. Your visuals came as a pleasant surprise - I like nature. While I glanced through the availability of information on the studies, I sensed a significant effort and consciousness to put potential volunteers at ease along with a sense of transparency.

That at least was my first impression. The "caring" aspect just struck me even with your present website (less glamour). It certainly has made an impact on my thinking and brought a different dimension into my perspective on clinical trials

Wow, your site is impressive. I actually never thought that a CRO would go to the extent that you seem to have to care for the volunteers to the extent that you do. Honestly, I did see some amount of extra care and concern in your website but nothing like what you have described. After reading your mail, although I have not had the chance to interact much with you, I now feel that too many of us have lost our human feelings and touch under the disguise of professionalism.
